

## Are you ready for your D2 compliance date?

With the IMO's Ballast Water Management now in force, ship owners need to be considering their implementation plans to avoid penalties.



All new vessels built since 8th September 2017 must comply with the IMO's Ballast Water Management D2 requirements of an onboard ballast water treatment system. Depending upon their next IOPP renewal survey date, the deadline for existing ships' implementation is between now and 7th September 2024, which ship owners need to begin planning for.
